

HOW TO DOWNLOAD YOUR CA DREAM ACT APPLICATION STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR)

Deadline: March 2, 2015

The California priority deadline for AB-540 students to submit and file the 2015-2016 *California Dream Act Application* is March 2, 2015.

The Marcus Foster Education Fund requires that you upload a copy of your **California Student Aid Report (SAR)** to your online application. 5-7 business days after you have filed your Dream Act Application, you will receive an email notifying you that your application has been processed and that your Student Aid Report (SAR) is now available. *PLEASE NOTE: Your SAR cannot automatically be sent to us - we do not have a school code. It is your responsibility to follow these instructions and submit*

At that point, please:

- Visit <https://dream.csac.ca.gov/> and click the green 'Login' button at the bottom right of the page.
- When prompted, enter the Student's Username & Password. Click 'Next'. You should see the words 'Current Application Status: Processed Successfully' on this screen in bold lettering.
- Click the blue button which reads 'View Processed Information'. On the following screen, enter the Student's 4-digit federal PIN number and Click 'Next'. You used this number to electronically sign your Dream Application.
- A separate window will open up with a five-page PDF. This is your Student Aid Report (SAR). Save this document to your computer.
- If a separate window did not open, please make sure that your pop-up disabler is turned off.

If you do not know how to disable your pop-up blocker, search Google or YouTube for your specific browser (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, etc.) and instructions.

Your application will be considered **INCOMPLETE** until we receive your SAR. Your SAR must include your name and your Expected Family Contribution (EFC).

After you download your SAR as a PDF, you will upload it to your online student application. No email attachments or hard copies can be accepted. All required application documents must be uploaded to your online application. For more help contact nguyen@marcusfoster.org.

It is recommended that you also make a WebGrants account with the California Student Aid Commission at this time. Please visit webgrants4students.org to create an account to stay informed regarding your Cal Grant eligibility.

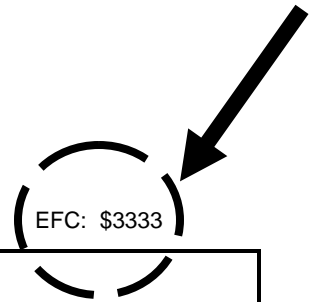
